Councilmember Ken Yeager Endorses Clark Williams for City Council

(September 18, 2006- Willow Glen, CA) -- Ken Yeager, the popular San Jose City Councilmember representing District 6, today endorsed Clark Williams, Vice President of the North Willow Glen Neighborhood Association, to replace him on the San Jose City Council.

Councilman Yeager highlighted Clark's service to the neighborhoods and his deep involvement in the community as the top reasons for his endorsement.
